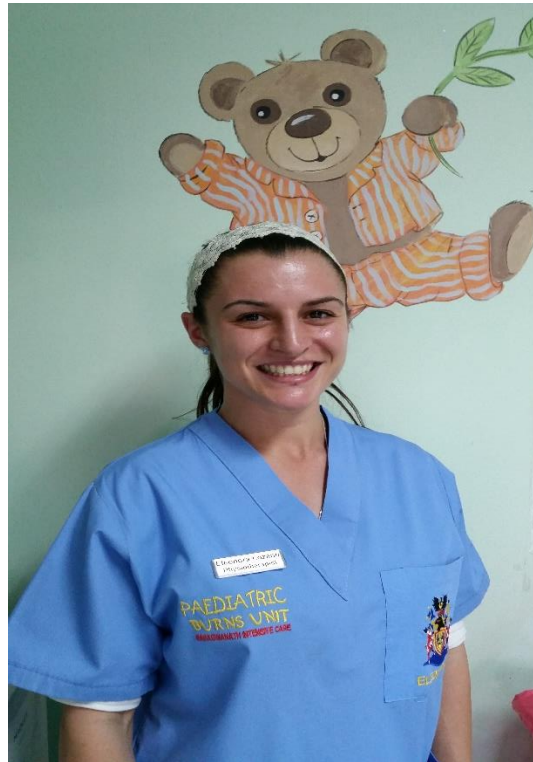


## ELEONORA LOZANO
