Outline/abstract of presentation:	<p>The diversity of health care services both nationally and internationally and the changing and developing role of physiotherapists within such services requires that all physiotherapists are equipped with an understanding of leadership and wider professional issues such as advocacy and implementation strategies for change and development.</p> <p>This one-day course, combined with a workshop at the conference, will focus on two key areas for the practice of physiotherapy: advocacy and leadership recognising that participants may be called to develop and manage their own service or other services from an early stage in and across the life span of their career.</p> <p>The course considers the 'individual and the organisation' where organisations may be units within more complex organisations, services and practice environments as well as communities of users. Understanding individual and interpersonal behaviours, team roles as well as leadership styles will enable participants to navigate the complex situations that face them in their career.</p>

Describe her/his preferred Belbin Team Roles & Bolman & Deal Leadership Orientation and be able to articulate how they may inform their behavior in their workplace 2. Discuss the importance and roles of leadership in healthcare, identifying opportunities for physiotherapists as agent of change.

Understand various theories of leading change & how they may be applied in specific personal professional circumstances. 5. Define and describe the components of an advocacy initiative 6. Plan an advocacy initiative related to his/her workplace or the professional community 7. Understand the role of the professional organisation in leading and advocating for the profession
